Notification
to the Signatory-States of the
CONVENTION ON INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN
ENDANGERED SPECIES OF WILD FAUNA AND FLORA
signed at Washington on 3 March, 1973

In application of Article XXV, Paragraphe 2, of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora, concluded at Washington on 3 March, 1973, the Federal Political Department has the honour to inform the Signatory-States that, since its previous notification, the plenipotentiaries of the following States have signed the said Convention:

Ireland,	on 1 November, 1974
Portugal,	on 6 December, 1974
Ecuador,	on 12 December, 1974
Ghana,	on 16 December, 1974
Norway,	on 23 December, 1974
Bolivia,	on 23 December, 1974
Peru,	on 30 December, 1974
Netherlands,	on 30 December, 1974

On 18 October, 1974, the Republic of Cyprus has deposited with the Federal Political Department an instrument of ratification of the aforementioned Convention, and on 21 November, 1974 the United Arab Emirates have deposited an instrument of accession to the Convention.

The present notification follows to that of 21 October, 1974.
