RATIFICATIONS BY PERU, COSTA RICA AND
SOUTH AFRICA

In application of Article XXV, Paragraph 2, of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora, concluded at Washington on 3 March 1973, the Federal Political Department has the honour to inform the Signatory-States and Members that instruments of ratification of the afore-mentioned Convention have been deposited with the Swiss Government by the following States:

Peru, on 27 June 1975
Costa Rica, on 30 June 1975
South Africa, on 15 July 1975.

In conformity with Article XXII, Paragraph 2, the Convention will enter into force on 25 September 1975 for Peru, on 28 September 1975 for Costa Rica and on 13 October 1975 for South Africa.

II

ACCESSION OF THE KINGDOM OF NEPAL

On 18 June 1975, based on Article XXI, the Kingdom of Nepal has deposited with the Swiss Government a declaration of accession to the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora.

The accession of Nepal will take effect on 16 September 1975, according to Article XXII, Paragraph 2, of the Convention.
