Notification

to the Member or Signatory States of the Convention on international trade in endangered species of wild fauna and flora concluded at Washington on March 3, 1973

ACCESSION OF AUSTRIA AND MALAWI

1. Based on Article XXI of the Convention, the Republic of Austria has deposited with the Swiss Government, on January 27, 1982, an instrument of accession to the Convention. This instrument of accession includes the following reservation:

"The Republic of Austria, according to Art.

XXIII, para 2, lit a), declares that she will
apply the convention under the reservation that
the following species included in Appendix I

Crocodylus porosus and Crocodylus cataphractus

will be treated as if included in Appendix II."

According to Article XXII, Paragraph 2, of the Convention, the accession of the Republic of Austria will take effect on April 27, 1982.

2. Based on Article XXI of the Convention, the Republic of Malawi has deposited with the Swiss Government, on February 5, 1982, an instrument of accession to the Convention.

According to Article XXII, Paragraph 2, of the Convention, the accession of the Republic of Malawi will take effect on May 6, 1982.

The present notification is addressed to the Governments of Signatory or Contracting States in conformity with Article XXV, Paragraph 2, of the Convention.
