High Contracting Parties entitled to vote	144
High Contracting Parties which voted "yes" or "no"	125
Two-thirds majority required	84
High Contracting Parties which voted <i>in favour</i> of the amendments	98
High Contracting Parties which voted <i>against</i> the amendments	27

by 98 voices against 27**
