Declaration of continuity by Latvia concerning the Conventions of 1929

On 26 November 1991, the Republic of Latvia deposited with the Swiss Federal Council an instrument constituting a declaration of continuity concerning the two Conventions of 1929. The Republic of Latvia was party to the said conventions since 14 October 1931.

The declaration took effect retroactively on 6 September 1991, day of the recognition of the independence of the Republic of Latvia by the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.

The present notification is made by the Swiss Federal Council in its capacity of depositary of the Conventions of 1929 and 1949.
