Notification to the States having participated at the Diplomatic Conference on Jurisdiction in Civil Matters, held at Lugano on 16 September 1988

CONVENTION ON JURISDICTION AND THE ENFORCEMENT OF JUDGMENTS IN CIVIL AND COMMERCIAL MATTERS

Ratification by the United Kingdom

The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland deposited with the Swiss Federal Council, on 5 February 1992, its instrument of ratification of the Convention.

The instrument contains the following declaration (original version):

"The Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, having considered the Convention aforesaid, hereby confirm and ratify the same in respect of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland only, but reserving the right to extend the Convention at a later date to any territory for whose international relations the Government of the United Kingdom is responsible."

According to its final provisions, the Convention will take effect in relation to the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland on the first day of the third month following the deposit of its instrument, i.e. on 1 May 1992.

The present notification is addressed to the States represented at the Conference in conformity with article 67 of the Convention.
