Verbleibende Herausforderungen

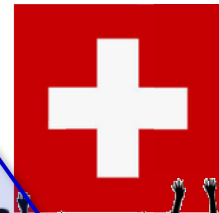
- Outcome Addis Abeba (Juli 2015)

 - Konsensqualität / -stabilität
- Zielrahmen: Anpassung ausgewählter Unterziele?
- Definition von Indikatoren
- Einbezug “aller” Interessensgruppen
- Umsetzung:

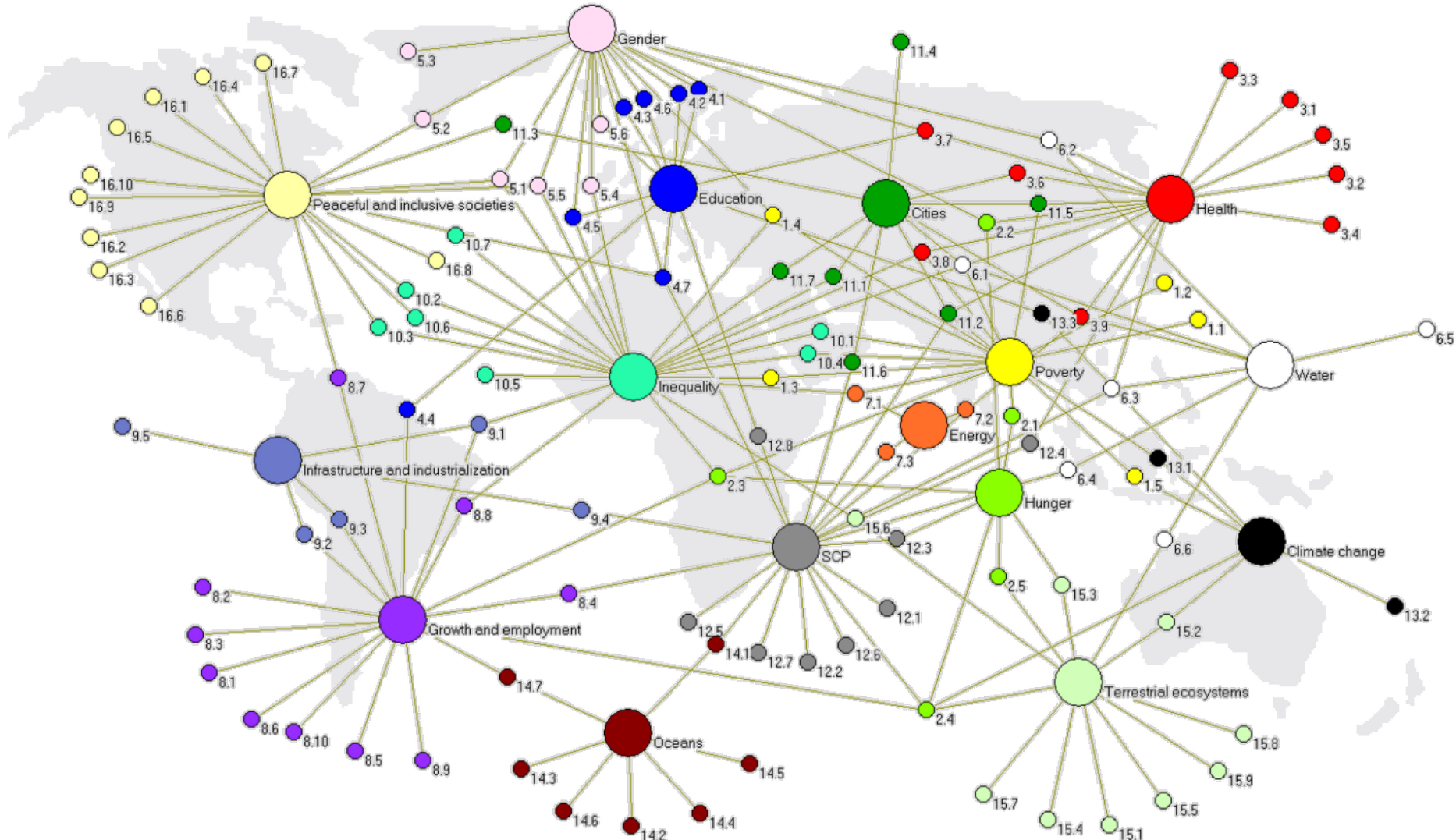

Open Working Group on SDGs

17 Proposed SDGs (July 2014)

1. End **poverty** in all its forms everywhere
2. End hunger, achieve **food security** and improved **nutrition**, and promote sustainable **agriculture**
- + 3. Ensure **healthy lives and promote well-being** for all at all ages
4. Ensure inclusive and equitable quality **education** and promote life-long learning opportunities for all
- + 5. Achieve **gender equality** and empower all women and girls
- + 6. Ensure availability and sustainable management of **water and sanitation** for all ← + DRR
7. Ensure access to affordable, reliable, sustainable, and modern **energy** for all
8. Promote sustained, inclusive and sustainable economic **growth**, full and productive **employment** and **decent work** for all ← + Migration
9. Build resilient infrastructure, promote inclusive and sustainable **industrialization** and foster **innovation**
10. Reduce **inequality** within and among countries ← + Migration
11. Make **cities** and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable ← + DRR
- + 12. Ensure sustainable **consumption and production** patterns
13. Take urgent action to combat **climate change** and its impacts ← + DRR
14. Conserve and sustainably use the oceans, seas and **marine resources** for sustainable development
15. Protect, restore and promote sustainable use of **terrestrial ecosystems**, sustainably manage forests, combat desertification, and halt and reverse land degradation and halt **biodiversity** loss
- + 16. Promote **peaceful and inclusive societies** for sustainable development, provide access to justice for all and build effective accountable and inclusive institutions at all levels
17. Strengthen the **means of implementation** and revitalize the **global partnership** for sustainable development ← + Migration

- **Internationale Partnerschaften**

z.B. Weltbank, WEF, UN Global Compact, Swiss Sustainable Finance etc.

- **Thematische Kernanliegen**

- Mobilisierung einheimischer Ressourcen
- Private Finanzflüsse:
Rolle Privatsektor, Rückflüsse, Hebelwirkung der APD
- Illegale Finanzflüsse (*Asset Recovery*)
- Monitoring & Rechenschaftspflicht (*Sustainability Reporting*)
- Geschlechtergleichstellung

■ Post-2015 Agenda

- Deklaration (*CBDR, Foreign occupation etc.*)
- UNO-Mechanismus für Technologietransfer
- *Follow-up & Review*
- Umsetzungsinstrumente, Übertragung Addis Abeba → Post-2015 Outcome



■ Financing for Sustainable Development

- Mobilisierung einheimischer Ressourcen: Höhe Steuereinnahmen, *enabling environment*
- Rolle & Bedeutung Privatsektor, *ESG-Reporting*
- Öffentliche Entwicklungshilfe: 0.7% des BNE / 0.15-0.2% für LDCs
- Internationale Zusammenarbeit: Einfluss Entwicklungsländer in IFIs, Steuerfragen, Handel etc.
