



Birth of a child in Armenia to parents who are not married: entry in the Swiss civil status register

Documents to submit

- original birth certificate (*) of your child
- original official decree (*) establishing filiation or recognition of paternity

If you (a parent) do not hold Swiss nationality and are not yet registered in the Swiss civil status register, please submit the following:

- original birth certificate (*)
- Original of civil status record (*) before this marriage mentioning the dissolved marriages and, in addition:
 - If the spouse was divorced before this marriage
 - Divorce certificate (*) that specifies when it entered into force
 - If the spouse was widowed before this marriage
 - Original death certificate (*) of late spouse
- original certificate of current residence (*)
- copy of passport
- copy of residence card, if applicable

The original documents are submitted to the civil status authority concerned in Switzerland and must not be older than six months. They will not be returned. Photocopies are not accepted. Additional documents may be required if necessary.

Legalisation / Translation / Apostille

Before being submitted to the Swiss representation, all original documents marked with an (*) must be affixed with an apostille, be translated into a Swiss national language by an authorised translator and notarised.

Please bring one copy of complete set of documents legalised for the Embassy.
