



Divorce in Armenia: entry in the Swiss civil status register

04/2024

Documents to submit

- original of divorce decree that specifies when it entered into force with apostille
- document stipulating the parental custody of any joint children, unless indicated on the divorce decree, with apostille
- change of address

The original documents are submitted to the civil status authority concerned in Switzerland and must not be older than six months. They will not be returned. Photocopies are not accepted. Additional documents may be required if necessary.

Legalisation / Translation / Apostille

All foreign civil status documents must be affixed with an apostille, then translated into a Swiss national language by an authorised translator, notarised and affixed with an apostille before being submitted to the Swiss representation.

Please note that foreign civil status documents which have been issued electronically and are verifiable online do not require an apostille. They do however need to be translated into a Swiss national language by an authorised translator, notarised and affixed with an apostille before being submitted to the Swiss representation.
