

Birth of a child in China to parents who are not married: Entry in the Swiss civil status register

Documents to submit to the competent Swiss representation in China

- □ Birth certificate (notarial certificate of birth), not older than 6 months, issued by a public notary and with apostille. The notarial certificate contains the translation and a copy of the original birth certificate.
- □ Passport copies of parents and if available passport copy of the child's foreign passport

Since 1 January 2014, China started to use a new version of the Medical Certificate of Birth. At the same time a new regulation was introduced that allows for children of at least one non-Chinese parent, to be registered with either a Chinese (Hànzì) or Latin name (Latin font). The family name of the newborn can be either from the father or from the mother.

Once the birth certificate has been issued, the information on it is determinant for the registration in the Swiss civil status register. The child's surname and first name must be translated into the Pinyin version for transcription to the Swiss civil status register.

If the parents decide to officially register their child with a Latin name, the Chinese parent may not be able to register the newborn in their Hukou in China. As a consequence, the child cannot apply for a Chinese passport, neither for further benefits (school etc.). However, strict application of this regulation may vary depending on province. In order for the child to enter and exit China with a Swiss passport, an "Entry and Exit"-booklet can be obtained at the competent Chinese authorities. For more information, please inquire with the local Hukou registration bureau.

The birth certificate (notarial certificate of birth) is submitted to the civil status authority concerned in Switzerland and must not be older than six months. It will not be returned. Additional documents may be required if necessary.

If the name of the father is registered on the birth certificate, this is automatically considered as recognition of paternity in China. Therefore, it is not necessary to submit any other documents besides the birth certificate to acknowledge paternity / confirm the child relationship. However, if only the mother is registered on the birth certificate, please contact us. In this case, we would need a notarial certificate of paternity acknowledgement, issued by a public notary and with apostille.

Subsequent change of name after registration has taken place

The registered name in the Swiss civil register can only be changed by a formal decision of change of name. Therefore, parents have to submit a written request for the change of name to the attention of the competent authority at the place of origin in Switzerland of the Swiss parent. The letter must be written in a national language of Switzerland (and/or English) and signed by both parents. A change of name will only be granted if legitimate reasons are given. There is no guarantee that the civil authority body will grant the request.

Chinese parent who is not yet registered in the Swiss civil status register:

If the Chinese parent is not yet registered in the civil status register, further documents are required:

- □ Birth certificate with names of the parents (notarial certificate of birth), issued by a public notary and with apostille
- □ Civil status certificate(s):
 - a) Declaration of your current civil status (affidavit), certified by a public notary and with apostille
 - b) Divorce certificate (notarial certificate of divorce), issued by a public notary and with apostille, if divorced at the Chinese civil registration office
 - c) Divorce decree, notarized by a public notary and with apostille, if divorced in court. In case of divorce by means of legal mediation by the court, a notarized certificate of legal effect with apostille must also be submitted.
 - d) Death certificate (notarial certificate of death) of the deceased spouse, issued by a public notary and with apostille, if widowed
- □ Certificate of residence, issued by a public notary and with apostille
- (certificate of current address and not a translation of the Hukou)
- Photocopy of a valid passport or identity card

If the parent concerned is not a Chinese citizen, please contact us.

The civil status documents are submitted to the civil status authority concerned in Switzerland and must not be older than six months. They will not be returned. Additional documents may be required if necessary.

Translation

Documents that are not written in a Swiss national language (German, French or Italian) or in English must be translated.

Apostille

Civil status documents must be provided with an apostille issued by the Chinese Ministry of Foreign Affairs. A list of Chinese Foreign Affairs Offices that issue apostilles can be found below.

Fees

Entry of the birth and an entry of the foreign parent in the Swiss civil status register are free of charge.

Further information and request for Swiss identity documents

Please register the birth of your child as soon as possible. A minimum of two months must be expected for the birth registration.

Once the birth has been entered in the civil status register, parents can order a Swiss passport and/or identity card via the website <u>www.schweizerpass.ch</u>.

A Swiss identity document can only be ordered once the birth of the child has been entered in the Swiss civil status register or the child's Swiss citizenship has been confirmed.
