

Leaflet SWISS SCHENGEN VISA MEDICAL TREATMENT

General application rules:

- Only visa applications with Switzerland as a main travel destination are accepted.
 In case of multiple destinations, the visa must be submitted at the Embassy of the country where the longest stay will be
- All requested documents have to be translated into German, French, Italian or English
 A list of recognized translators can be found at the Embassy website:
 https://www.eda.admin.ch/countries/egypt/en/home/dienstleistungen/arzt-anwalt.html
- If a requested document cannot be provided, there must be a written explanation instead, clarifying why the document is not available
- The visa fee will not be refunded in case of refusal or withdrawal.
- Communication regarding visa matters are only accepted in written form to info.cheg@vfsglobal.com or by calling +20248837966
- The mandatory "Schengen Consultation", which takes a processing time period of at least 10 working days, can only be started upon receiving a complete application file meeting the requirements
- The Embassy reserves the right to ask for additional documents or a personal interview with the applicant

How to apply:

Prior to the submission of a visa request, an appointment has to be fixed with our external service provider <u>VFS Center</u> **only online** on the VFS website: https://visa.vfsglobal.com/egy/en/che/

Requirements	
Visa Application Form	https://www.eda.admin.ch/countries/egypt/en/home/visa/entry-ch/up-90-days/documents-schengen.html# Must be duly filled-in and signed by the applicant!
Passport	 original and 1 copy of biometric data page plus all non-empty pages issued within the last 10 years contains at least 2 blank pages must be valid for at least 3 months beyond the return from the planned trip
Previous passport	 covering the past 7 years copies of biometric data page plus all non-empty pages
1 passport-size personal photo	 with white background not older than 6 months
Round-trip Ticket	> only air travel reservation (not confirmed)

Certificate from the local medical doctor / institution	> containing the medical history of the patient and what kind of medical treatment is needed
	In certain cases, the embassy might request to have the certificate verified by the embassy's medical doctor
Original Certificate of employment (HR-letter)	 containing the following information: date of recruitment (hiring date) salary level position confirmation of annual leave approval
For company owners	> original and copy of the commercial registry and valid tax card
For students	proof of enrolment in school / university for the current academic year
International Travel	covering the entire period of intended stay
Insurance	> valid for all Schengen countries
	minimum coverage must be EUR 30'000.00 (includes expenses of repatriation fo medical reasons, urgency medical attention, emergency hospital treatment or death during the stay)
	> a printout certificate/policy in English of *AMAN sticker* on the passport
Bank statement	> in original
	covering the past six months
	only current or saving accounts (Deposit Certificates will not be considered!)
	closing balance must show sufficient means to cover the expenses of the planned trip
Visa fees	> payable in EGP (only exact amount is accepted!)

These requirements should be sent <u>directly to the applicant</u> , to be added to her/his visa application file				
Official invitation letter	 on official hospital / medical institution paper, stamped and signed containing the following information: full address and contacts of the medical institution confirmation that it can perform the specific medical treatment and the patient will be accepted accordingly mentioning the financial arrangements made (approx costs, deposits, payment terms) duration of the planned stay for medical treatment mentioning eventual accompanying persons 			

Additional special requirements				
For foreigners living in Egypt	>	must have a residence permit in Egypt valid for at least 3 months beyond the return from the planned trip		
For minors	>	if the minor travels without parents or legal guardian: consent of parental authority or legal guardian provided either through a notarized certificate or by a letter signed at the Embassy or VFS office		
	>	if the minor travels with one parent or legal guardian: consent of parental authority or legal guardian, who is not travelling with the child, provided either through a notarized certificate or by a letter signed at the Embassy or VFS office		
	>	passport copy of both parents (biometric data page + page with the signature) Translated Birth Certificate of the minor.
