


ANIMALS

Chhimayed Tenzin Pelyang, 11 years



Kinzom Sheryang Pema, 9 years




Five friends loved to go to the river. They were two lions and three cats, who lived in a forest.

In the middle of the night, I looked outside my window and saw two fairies. I listened carefully and realised they were fighting about a flower. The flower was a beautiful lotus.


I thought about a solution and searched how to make a lotus.

MAGIC FROM A UNICORN


Woesalma Chhodron Chogyel, 7 years






Outside my window, I saw a bear who had been hurt by a hunter's arrows.

MAX & THE BIRD


Kinley Phuentsho Dorji, 9 years

DRAWING WHAT I SEE



Karzay Yeega Seldon, 7 years




I looked outside my window and saw a Mermaid. She was very pretty.

FINDING A LOST PET


Kundan Kumar, 12 years



THE GREEN ROBOT




Once there was a robot with green skin. He was short, but still very big. He lived in a dark forest with four of his friends, two lions and two boys.


AN ADVENTURE



Sonam Choki Dema, 10 years





A MAGIC DOOR TO SPACE






GOING OUTSIDE






THE LION, THE MOUSE AND AN APPLE




SAVING A FRIEND

THREE DOGS FIND A HOME






HELPING AN INJURED BIRD




