Applicants who wish to apply for a six months or one year multiple entry visa are not obliged to provide a 180 (365) days coverage. Applications for official passport holders can be submitted at the Embassy of Switzerland, visa section, from Monday to Thursday, between 09:00 am and 11:00 am, with a prior appointment. For an appointment, please write an email to: newdelhi.visa@eda.admin.ch

Starting from 02.11.2015, all diplomatic representations of the Schengen member states in India have to capture the biometric data (finger scans) of persons applying for a Schengen visa. Therefore, personal appearance of the applicant is mandatory to submit a visa application, if the fingerprints have not been captured during the last 59 months. If the fingerprints have been captured during the last 59 months, the application can be sent through a representative.

The passport collection will be the next working day at the same time.
