0	Issued within the last 10 years and with at least 3 months validity after the scheduled return, with at least two blank pages. Handwritten passports and passports with observations regarding the front page (bio data) cannot be accepted.

0	White background, not older than 6 months (size 35 – 40 mm in width, not copied or scanned picture).			
0	Picture has to be pasted on the application form, stapled or pinned pictures cannot be accepted.

0	Proof of accommodation: evidence on where student is staying at during the entire time within the Schengen zone.

0	English language certificates such as TOEFL or IELTS is mandatory. German, French or Italian language certificates if available.

0	Minimum coverage of 30,000 Euro per person.			
0	Coverage of all expenses which might arise in connection with repatriation for medical reasons, urgent medical attention and/or emergency hospital treatment.			
0	The insurance has to cover the entire stay in the Schengen territory.			
0	Applicants who wish to apply for a six months or one year multiple entry visa are not obliged to provide a 180 (365) day coverage. It is sufficient to submit an insurance policy covering the first journey.

Personal ITR (only ITR-V, Indian Income Tax Return Verification Form or Acknowledgement is accepted) If Self-Employed and/or company owner : Business registration certificate / GST Registration with annex A & B / Partnership Deed / Proof of proprietorship, or other proof of ownership. Last 3 months personal & business bank. Company's & personal ITR (only ITR-V, Indian Income Tax Return Verification Form or Acknowledgement is accepted) for the last 2 assessment years. If student or unemployed : Parents or legal guardians must provide their personal bank account statements for the last 3 months. Personal ITR (only ITR-V, Indian Income Tax Return Verification Form or Acknowledgement is accepted) for the last 2 assessment years. 	
0	Clear photocopies of valid UK, USA, or CAN visas (if any). Passport: photocopy of the 1 st page (bio data) and last page	
0	In case of visa refusal by an Embassy or High Commission within the last 2 years: Submit refusal notice and/or a written explanation about the reasons of refusal	
0	Visa fee : • Free of charge.
