demics, business leaders and development experts to explore challenges and opportunities related to water

and Cooperation SDC, contributed valuable insights into Switzerland's commitment to sustainable development, especially in water governance (watch here). The platform aims at promoting fruitful exchanges among partners in water and environmental issues in Kuwait.

Swiss-Kuwaiti Ramadan Diwaniya and Friendship

In March, the Swiss Residence hosted the second Diwaniya, co-organized with the Swiss Kuwaiti Business Platform, bringing together many long-time



friends of Switzerland for an evening of cultural exchange and meaningful connection. Held during the holy month of Ramadan<u>, this special event was a</u> moment to celebrate friendship, mutual respect, and the deep-rooted ties between the Swiss and Kuwaiti communities.

Guests included representatives from three generations of Kuwaiti families with longstanding personal and professional links to Switzerland. The event was also featured on KTV2 <u>(watch here)</u>, underlining the growing public interest in our bilateral relation. Our Diwaniya will continue to serve as an important platform for people-to-people diplomacy, while honoring local tradition and promoting dialogue between cultures.

Scientific Exchange on Diabetes Prevention

On the 12 of May, the Residence hosted a major

event to highlight a Swiss-Kuwaiti project about diabetes. This initiative brought together researchers, doctors, and health profes-



sionals, reaffirming the strong potential of scientific cooperation between the two countries. The evening featured contributions from four high-level speakers:

Professor Dr. Pedro Marques-Vidal (CHUV Lausanne), Dr. Abdullah AlKandari (KISR), Dr. Ebaa AlOzairi (Dasman Diabetes Institute), and Mr. Wolfram Alderson (KDD).



The research project is funded by the <u>Leading House</u> <u>MENA</u> program, underscoring Switzerland's support for long-term academic and scientific partnerships with the region.

Promoting Dialogue on Labor Rights

On the 30 of April, the Residence hosted an informal discussion and a reception in cooperation with the **International Labor Organization (ILO)** to mark the

launch of an inter-regional programme aimed (with the financial support of the Swiss Agency for Development and



Cooperation SDC) at strengthening labor migration governance between Africa and the Arab States. The event brought together representatives from embassies, UN agencies, and local civil society for an informal exchange and networking.

Business Law and Finance

The Swiss Residence once again served as a hub for economic dialogue and networking by hosting an event with our **GBCK** friends, featuring a presentation by Mr. Sammy Al Shatti from **Al Tamimi & Company**. His briefing on recent legal updates in Kuwait's business landscape sparked engaged discussion among attendees from various sectors.



The following week, the Residence welcomed the co-CEO of the **Swiss Bank Vontobel**, Christel Rendu de Lint, for a friendly lunch with representatives of the Kuwaiti business and financial community. The gathering



strengthened mutual understanding and bilateral ties.

The Embassy recently hosted a meeting with the the leaderships of the Swiss company CleanGreens Solutions SA and its Kuwaiti partner GreenLife. The two companies are expanding their cooperation to pro-

marks a significant leap in agricultural innovation, using Swiss-developed technology.
