## Info sheet and checklist for study Visa (for information purposes only)

This information sheet concerns only applicants applying for a D visa in Switzerland. All other applicants must approach the respective Embassies of the Czech Republic, Estonia, Latvia, Poland, Finland, Slovenia, Slovakia, and France as mentioned in the Swiss Embassy Website: <a href="https://www.eda.admin.ch/bishkek">www.eda.admin.ch/bishkek</a>

D Visa applications are forwarded to the competent cantonal immigration authorities for decision. The processing time <u>require at least 10 to 12 weeks</u>. The Embassy is not allowed to issue an entry visa without a positive decision of the mentioned authority.

	4 recent and identical photos (one for each application form and one for scanning). The photographs must fulfill Schengen standards, Size 3.5 x 4	
	2 copies of the following documents: - Attestation/enrolment confirmation from the school/University with program - Proof of payment of the tuition fees - Proof of sufficient financial means for accommodation and daily needs for the whole duration of the stay - Diploma of already completed studies - Letter of motivation which includes the reason for studies in Switzerland as well as the future plans after termination of studies - The applicant has to prove the knowledge of a foreign language that is required by the school in Switzerland by a test
