



Death in North Macedonia: entry in the Swiss civil status register

19.01.2022

Documents

- ☐ Original international extract from the death register CIEC Form C, not older than 6 months issued by a North Macedonian civil registry office or the North Macedonian representation abroad.
- Or
- ☐ Original death certificate issued by the civil registry office of the place of death with apostille and translation.
- ☐ Swiss identity documents of the deceased (passport and identity card). The voided documents can be returned for commemorative purposes if the family requests this when submitting them.
- ☐ contact information for reaching a member of the surviving family

The original documents are submitted to the civil status authority concerned in Switzerland and must not be older than six months. They will not be returned. Photocopies are not accepted. Additional documents may be required if necessary.

Translation

Documents that are not in a Swiss national language or in English must be translated.

Legalisation

With the exception of CIEC documents, all documents and court decisions must be certified by an apostille.
