

Checklist for National visa (type D): Student with a stay in Switzerland for more than 90 days

The application must be submitted **personally** at the Visa Section, Embassy of Switzerland, Diplomatic Quarter, KSA-11693 Riyadh between Sunday and Thursday, from 08:30 am to 11:00 am, by appointment only.

If your documents are not in a Swiss language (German, French, Italian), English or Spanish, they need to be translated in one of the aforementioned languages.

Please submit the documents in the exact order given below, please do not staple any documents:

Please note that:

The Embassy of Switzerland reserves the right to ask for additional documents and/or for a personal interview.

Visas for Students with the purpose of Study in Switzerland are **free of charge**. To be noted that the final decision if the visa fee is waived is taken by the Embassy of Switzerland.

The complete application will be forwarded to the <u>cantonal immigration authority</u> for decision. The procedure takes at least 8 -12 weeks. Once the application has been approved, you will have to submit your original passport or travel document to this Embassy in order to obtain your visa.

No copies are made on your behalf and incomplete applications will not be accepted.
