



VISA D – STUDIES

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR STUDYING IN SWITZERLAND:

(READ CAREFULLY BEFORE PREPARING YOUR DOCUMENTS)

- Applications for family reunification are only accepted by the Swiss Consulate General in Istanbul
- Applications with missing documents will not be accepted
- Applicants must appear in person
- Electronic documents (documents from the online system) are not accepted
- In case of missing photocopies etc., the consulate cannot photocopy documents
- No additional time will be granted to complete the missing documents.
- In case of an incomplete application, you must request a new appointment by E-Mail
- The Consulate General of Switzerland in Istanbul has the right to request additional documents from you

DOCUMENTS FOR THE APPLICATION VISA D – STUDIES

PLEASE PREPARE THE DOCUMENTS IN THE SEQUENCE GIVEN BELOW, WITHOUT **STAPLES, PAPER CLAMPS OR VIEWPOCKETS**

- ALL DOCUMENTS MUST BE TRANSLATED INTO ONE OF THE **OFFICIAL LANGUAGES**
- A **PHOTOCOPY OF EACH ORIGINAL** MUST BE MADE
- THE **ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS AND PHOTOCOPIES** MUST BE SUBMITTED IN **2 SEPARATE** BUNDLES

VISA D – STUDIES

ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS ATTACHED TO THE VISA APPLICATION FORM MUST BE PROVIDED IN DUPLICATE TRANSLATED INTO ONE OF THE SWISS NATIONAL LANGUAGES

Two copies The student and/or the guarantor/sponsor in Switzerland must proof possession of sufficient funds according to the cantonal requirements to cover the study. At least one of the proofs listed below must be provided (in duplicate):

- A declaration of commitment (Verpflichtungserklärung) and proof of income or assets of a solvent person resident in Switzerland (if the latter is of foreign origin, he must also have a residence permit)
- Confirmation from a bank licensed in Switzerland confirming the existence of sufficient assets. Banks licensed in Switzerland are those banks, which have been approved by the Swiss Financial Market Supervisory Authority (FINMA)

- A fixed guarantee for the granting of training scholarships or loans **(in Swiss francs)**
- **Two copies** of the payment confirmation covering the school fees for the first year

Two copies Letter of acceptance respectively certificate of matriculation of the school or University in Switzerland (original & two (2) copies)

Two copies Previous diplomas and school certificates (original & two (2) copies)

Two copies CV (curriculum vitae) (in duplicate)

Two copies Letter of motivation including intentions for the future (in duplicate)

Written and signed declaration by the student that he/she will return to Switzerland after completing his/her studies (in duplicate)

Visa fee: For students the visa fee is for free

INFORMATION: The applicant will be tested in the chosen study language

Scholarship: Switzerland offers each year two University scholarships to Turkish citizen who would like to study in Switzerland. These 9-months research scholarships are only open to university graduates. Applications must be submitted to the Turkish Ministry of Education in Ankara in October/November. The process for scholarships is conducted in cooperation with the Turkish Ministry of Education. Every August the Ministry publishes an information on its website www.meb.gov.tr. VISA PROCEDURE

- The application will be forwarded to the responsible immigration office in Switzerland.
- The Consulate General of Switzerland in Istanbul can only issue D visas that have been approved by the responsible immigration office.
- It takes **at least** 8-12 weeks for the application to be completed.
- If your application is approved, please send your passport and the “Authorization for Visa Issue” to the Consulate General of Switzerland in Istanbul.
