POLICE COOPERATION

Police attaché stationed in Belgrade and Tirana, mandated to fight international crime in the Western Balkans.



MIGRATION

Partnerships with Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo, Serbia and North Macedonia.



MILITARY PEACE SUPPORT

Swiss contingents for KFOR (maximum 215 soldiers) in Kosovo and EUFOR (maximum 22 observers and staff officers) in Bosnia and Herzegovina and a military attaché in Serbia.



ECONOMY

Within the framework of the European Free Trade Association (EFTA), Switzerland maintains a network of free trade agreements in the Western Balkans with North Macedonia (2002), Albania (2010), Serbia (2010), Montenegro (2012), Bosnia and Herzegovina (2015) and Kosovo (2025).

Diplomatic secondment in senior position at the Office of the High Representative in Bosnia and Herzegovina.
