Notification to the States parties to the Convention for the Establishment of a European Organisation for the Exploitation of Meteorological Satellites (EUMETSAT), concluded at Geneva on 24 May 1983

Accession by the Republic of Slovenia

On 19 February 2008, the Republic of Slovenia deposited with the Swiss Government its instrument of accession to the Convention of 24 May 1983 for the establishment of a European Organisation for the Exploitation of Meteorological Satellites, as amended by the Protocol of 5 June 1991, and to the Protocol of 1st December 1986 on the privileges and immunities of the European Organisation for the Exploitation of Meteorological Satellites.

Pursuant to its article 17, paragraph 4, the amended Convention has entered into force for the Republic of Slovenia on the date of the deposit of the instrument of accession, i.e. on 19 February 2008. The Protocol on the privileges and immunities will enter into force, pursuant to its article 24, paragraph 4, 30 days after the deposit of the instrument of accession, i.e. on 20 March 2008.

The present notification is addressed by the depositary (www.eda.admin.ch/depositary) to the States parties in conformity with article 20 of the Convention.
