



Birth of a child in Israel to parents married to each other: Entry in the Swiss civil status register

05.04.2022

Documents to submit

- Original birth certificate of your child (Teudat Leida), bilingual (Hebrew/English) with Apostille

In the case that parents are not Israeli citizens:

- Original confirmation of birth (Ishur Leida), bilingual (Hebrew/English) with Apostille
- Copy of child's foreign passport or identity document (if applicable)

The original documents are submitted to the competent civil status authority in Switzerland and must **not be older than six months**. Documents will not be returned. Photocopies of civil status documents are not accepted. Additional documents may be required if necessary.
