



Death in Israel: entry in the Swiss civil status register

05.04.2022

Documents to submit

- original death certificate (Teudat Ptira)
- Swiss identity documents of the deceased (passport and identity card). The voided documents can be returned for commemorative purposes if the family requests this when submitting them.
- contact information for reaching a member of the surviving family

The original documents are submitted to the civil status authority concerned in Switzerland and must not be older than six months. They will not be returned. Photocopies are not accepted. Additional documents may be required if necessary.

Translation

Documents in Hebrew do not have to be translated.

Legalisation

All foreign civil status documents must be apostilled before being submitted to the Swiss representation:
