Travel restrictions:

Foreign nationals are not allowed to enter or transit in Thailand EXCEPT for diplomats, those with a Thai work permit, crew, or otherwise permitted by the PM. Those allowed must have a 'fit to fly' certificate. See [Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand](#) or [International Air Transport Association website](#).

NEW: Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand (CAAT) has issued an order banning **inbound** (i.e into Thailand) passenger planes until 23:59 on 18 April EXCEPT for (a) State or military aircraft, (b) Emergency landing aircraft, (c) Technical landing with no disembarking passengers, (d) Humanitarian, aid, medical and relief flights, (e) Repatriation aircraft, and (f) Cargo aircraft.
